The School of Education Studies at Dublin City University offers a two-year part-time taught MSc. Programme – eLearning in Education and Training Management.

The programme has been designed to meet the needs of practitioners from across the primary, post-primary, further, higher, and adult education sectors as well as from corporate industry, nursing personnel, non-government organisations, governmental departments, and other state agencies.

What will you learn?

- Gain an in-depth understanding of the theory, concepts and methods at the forefront of knowledge about learning, educational applications of multimedia and leadership.
- Critically evaluate the emerging theories and practices of eLearning.
- Design and develop eLearning resources that can be used in a range of workplace contexts.
- Carry out systematic action reflection cycles and evaluating the effectiveness of changing practice.
- Research the pedagogical issues and educational opportunities for learning opened up by digital technologies.



Philosophy of Programme

A variety of perspectives and new approaches to teaching, training and learning are explored. Participants are encouraged to provide evidence-based accounts of how they are improving work practices within their organisation and generating new knowledge.

There are opportunities to collaboratively reflect on and share learning with peers in class sessions and through virtual learning and online discussions. Participants are encouraged to make use of multimedia forms of representations to express and share learning.

The dynamic of this applied programme rests with the participants who choose topics for research, which leads to further improvement in their workplace. It builds knowledge and understanding of the dynamics at play in what is becoming an increasingly complex working and living environment.
