- **Action Learning and Action Research Journal**

Action Learning and Action Research Journal, published by Action Learning Action Research Association Ltd ([ALARA](http://www.alara.net.au)), is an international journal that publishes accounts and analyses of the use of action learning, action research and associated approaches to any field of activity that aligns with ALARA's constitutional vision. This vision is to create a more equitable, just, joyful, productive, peaceful and sustainable society by promoting local and global change through the wide use of Action Learning and Action Research by individuals, groups and organisations. <https://journal.alara.net.au>

- **Action Learning: Research and Practice**

The *Journal of Action Learning: Research and Practice* publish articles which advance knowledge and assist the development of practice through the processes of action learning. It is a peer-reviewed journal published by Taylor & Francis three times p.a. and listed in the 2018 ABS Journal Quality Guide (Management Development and Education).
